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National Service Scheme

National Service Scheme, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports Govt. of India, popularly known as NSS was launched in Gandhiji's Birth Centenary Year 1969, in 37 Universities involving 40,000 students with primary focus on the development of personality of students through community service. NSS department of the college has been a vibrant and active unit. It has been rendering various services to the society. At present, the college has 5 NSS units with 500 volunteers. The overall objective of this scheme is educational and services to community. It is student centred program in which projects are implemented by NSS volunteers.

NSS department organizes various 1-day & 7-days camps every year in which cleanness drives, blood donation camps, various awareness lectures and rallies on social evils are conducted.

The main objectives of National Service Scheme (NSS) are:

- 1. Understand the community in which they work and identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem-solving
- 2. Develop among volunteers sense of social and civic responsibility
- 3. Utilise volunteers knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems
- 4. Develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities
- 5. Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes.
- 6. Practise national integration and social harmony



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1. Registration of NSS Volunteers for the session 2020-21

Every year as per requirement of NSS department Punjabi University, Patiala, Guru Nanak College, Budhlada requires registering 5 Unit voluntarily (500 students) with NSS Department, Punjabi University, Patiala. In 2020-21 on 15/9/2020 NSS of Guru Nanak College, Budhlada started the voluntary registration process and get registered 500 students from different departments, different courses with required male-female number ratios. The attached registration Data has all basic details of all registered students with NSS of Guru Nanak College, Budhlada. In the session 2020-21 total 249 male and 251 female students get registered with NSS, Guru Nanak College, Budhlada.

NSS coordinator Dr.Satgur Singh along with other NSS officers Assistant Professor Gurdeep Singh, Dr.Gurjas Kaur, Assistant Professor Manisha and Assistant Professor Simranjeet Singh conducted an orientation program for the newly Admitted students about various achievements of NSS and explained about the activities conducted by the NSS such as College Beautification, NSS camps, Social Awareness against Drugs, Stubble burning, Blood Donation etc.

2. Activity Name: Awareness drive in the area among the farmers regarding preventive Measures against Covid-19

During COVID pandemics, The lockdown being enforced in many places requires adapting practice through innovative solutions. Based on guidance given by the World Health Organization, This includes the need of promotion of of basic protective gear (such as cloth face masks), alongside social distancing and proper hygiene practices such as hand washing and cleaning surfaces may be sufficient to ensure the safety of community people. For this, NSS of Guru Nanak College, Budhlada under the guidance of Principal Dr.Kuldip Singh took an initiative for awareness among the proletriat class of society regarding covid-19 in respect of following prevention measures against the Virus and also motivated the farmers and agriculture labourers to use mask while they are working in fields. NSS officer Assistant Professor Gurdeep Singh along with 5 NSS voluntary students played a very contributory role in this awareness drive. They approached a Hundreds of farmers and labourers to instruct the proper uses of a mask, and also distributed Covid-19 prevention instruction pamphlets. They also allievate the fear of number of local people and shopkeepers and motivated them to follow Covid-19 prevention Instructions.



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

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


1 Activity Name: Online webinar on contribution of Punjab in Indian freedom struggle
