The Department of Mathematics was established in 1981, keeping in mind the demand of the students of the area, M.Sc. Mathematics course started in 2010.

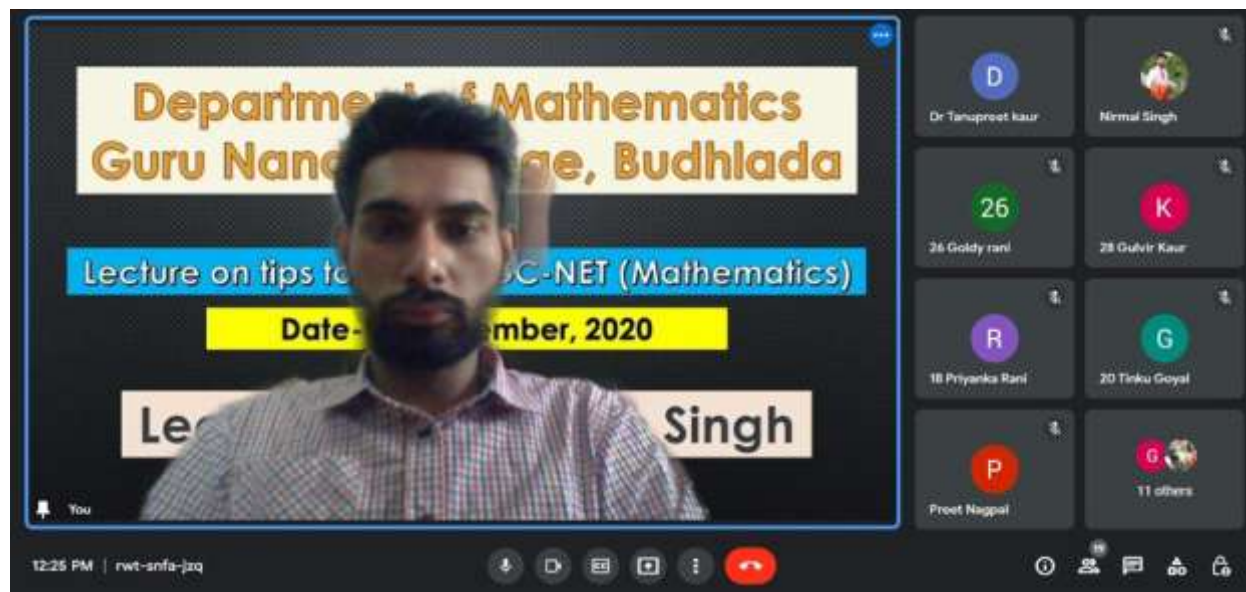

The Department invites these alumni, to interact with the student's time to time to share their own experience.



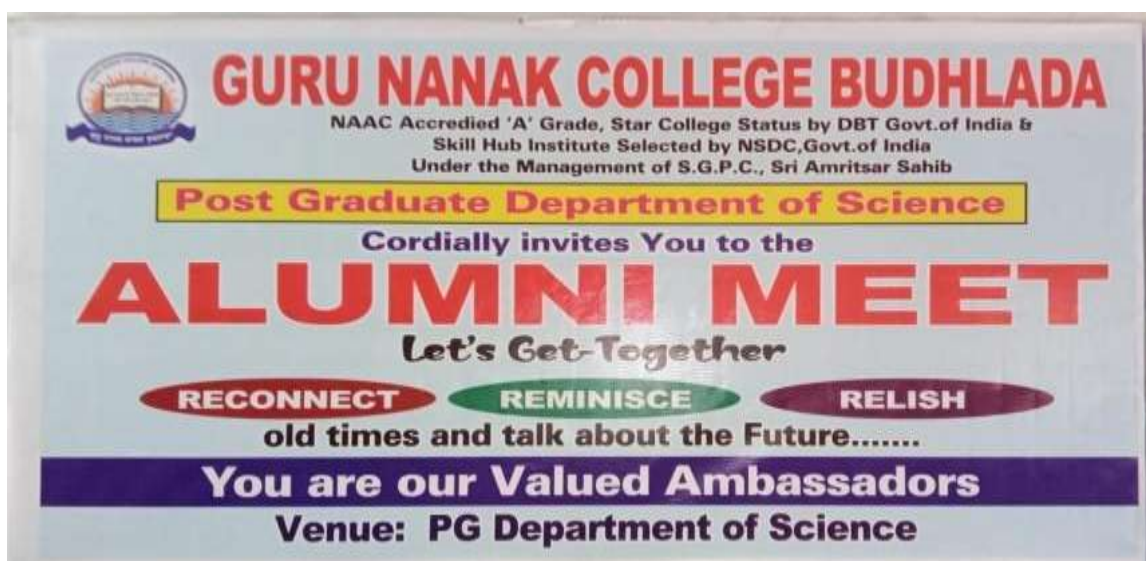
DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE

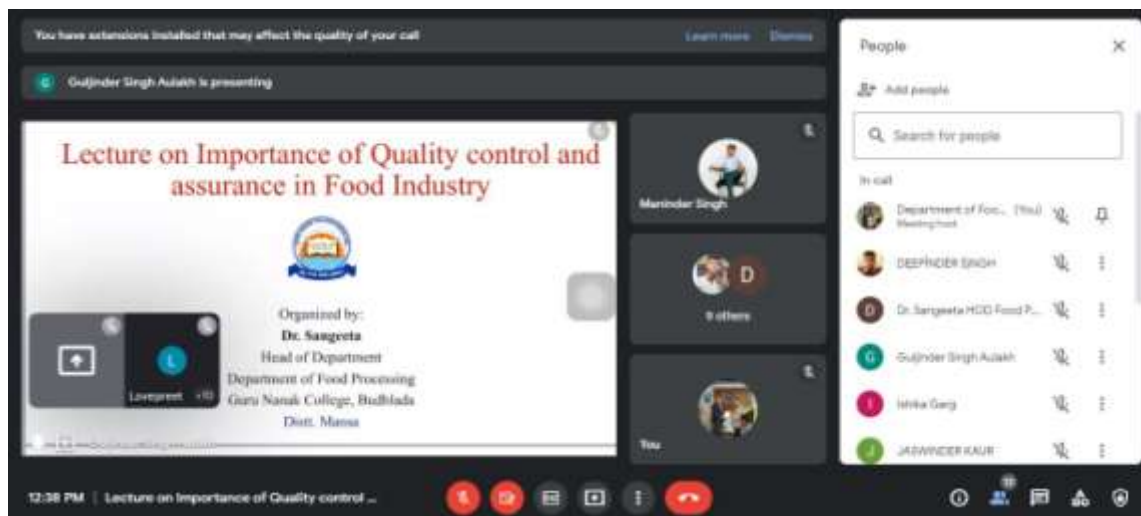
